Where To Download Blue Ridge Fire Towers Landmarks

The 70-foot tower, constructed in 1941, offered a prime lookout for forest fires for decades, and now stands as an excellent scenic lookout. After savoring the view, the hike descends from the tower, retracing its outbound steps along FS450 to the Blue Ridge Parkway.
