How the MOT disciplinary process works - Matters of Testing

To become an MOT tester, you must take a Level 2 Award in MOT Testing. If you are already an MOT tester, you must complete a minimum of three hours of Annual Training each year and complete an Annual Assessment to maintain your testing status. MOT testers will no longer need to attend a five-year refresher course. +

MOT Annual Assessment

Mandatory MOT testing restarted across England, Scotland and Wales on 1 August 2020, so if your MOT is due after that, you'll need to book a test if you want to keep your car on the road. If your MOT expired on or after 30 March and before 1 August, you automatically get the six-month extension granted to drivers because of the pandemic.

MOT Test of Brakes (1) Efficiency and balance of brakes is usually checked on a roller brake tester. In certain cases where a roller brake tester may not be used (for example on certain 4-wheel drive vehicles) it may be necessary to check brake efficiency and balance on a road test, with a portable decelerometer (pictured below).
