Inpatient rehabilitation facility patients have been found to have improved quality of life, better ambulation and confidence,

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overall mobility, and increased prosthesis use with less associated pain. If safety is the sole concern, evidence supports rehabilitation in either an inpatient rehabilitation facility or a skilled nursing facility. 33-35

The CENT reporting guidelines , are intended for medical N-of-1 trials, the SCRIBE 2016 guidelines , are intended for SCEDs in the behavioral sciences (and largely used in neuropsychological rehabilitation).

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
